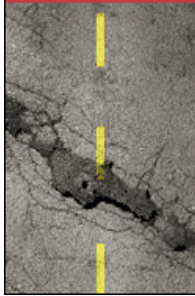
Disa Automotive Opens U.S. Distribution Center
